## TUSCARAWAS COUNTY YMCA Small Pool Rules

The lifeguard reserves the right to ask a patron to exit the pool or pool area if any of the rules are violated. The lifeguard has the final say.

- Anyone under the age of 18 years old MUST be accompanied by an adult in the water. THIS POOL IS NOT GUARDED.
   KEEP YOUR EYES ON YOUR CHILDREN AT ALL TIMES AND STAY WITHIN ARMS REACH OF ALL NON-SWIMMERS!
- Diving, tossing children into the air and standing or sitting on shoulders will not be permitted due to shallow water depths.
- Please shower prior to entering the pool.
- Absolutely no food or drinks are permitted in the Small Pool area (water or sport drinks in a re-sealable plastic bottle permitted)
- When a class is scheduled in the Small Pool, only those participating in the class will be permitted in the water. Spectators are asked to be respectful of the instructor and participants by keeping noise levels at a minimum.
- No children are permitted in the pool during Adult Swim unless accompanied by a YMCA swim instructor.
- Equipment may be retrieved from the lifeguard on the Large Pool deck. Please return your equipment to the lifeguard as you leave the pool area.
- Due to excessive damage to our equipment in the past, we will no longer be offering the YMCA's noodles to our swimmers during Adult and Family Swim. You are welcome to bring your own in to use.
